



Player's Tournament/Event Contract

To be completed before traveling
out of town for a tournament/event

The KC Sabres Hockey Association encourages all players to be accompanied on out of town trips, but we recognize that this is not always feasible. While the statements within the For the Good of the Game outline the players' commitment to fair play and proper conduct, the Sabres wish to make this clear for any youth traveling with a team with or without a parent or guardian with them.

Specifically, the FAIR PLAY CODE FOR PLAYERS includes the following points:

1. I will play by the rules of hockey and in the spirit of the Game.
2. I will control my temper – fighting or “mouthing-off” can spoil the activity of everyone.
3. I will respect my opponents.
4. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me I will accept their decisions and show them respect.

The Edmonton Minor Hockey Association Operating Directives and their Coaches Handbook also places the responsibility for the players with the coach. These responsibilities include:

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

“As an organization dedicated to excellence, the EMHA strongly discourages the use and/or consumption of alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco and tobacco products by all its members at all hockey related activities where minors are present. Alcohol, non-prescription drugs, tobacco and tobacco products are destructive to the minds and bodies of athletes and are destructive to our objective towards a safe and fun environment.” Note: The entire trip, for CHA insurance purposes, is considered as a “hockey related activity”. All players are considered as minors even though they may reach 18 years of age during the hockey season.

DAMAGE TO ARENAS

“Associations shall be held responsible for damages to arenas caused by any tem or team members. Further, any player or team that shall cause damage or deface arenas may be suspended until such time (and maybe longer) as the damages are paid in full.” This shall apply to the hotel room(s) and bus that may be used.

THEFT AND VANDALISM

“Any team members who are found responsible for theft of private or community property, or who damage or deface rinks, arenas, community property and private property on or adjacent to the arena property may face suspension..”

I/we, _____ as the parent(s) or guardian(s) of the undersigned player also acknowledge that I/we will be responsible for all costs associated with the undersigned player being escorted back to Edmonton with one of the coaches or the team manager.
